Home Learning

At Primrose Hill we believe education is a partnership between our school, pupils and their families. We understand the importance of downtime however some learning is required at home to consolidate the learning taking place in school. Each week your child will receive a home learning sheet in their home learning book. Below you will find the weekly expectations for your child.

Books

All books must be returned on Monday morning, this will allow staff to look at the work completed and prepare the books for the following week. Books will be marked using a stamp to show an adult has looked at and checked your child's work.

Weekly expectations

- ★ Read their school reading book for 15 minutes 5 days a week.
- ★ Complete the counting activity in the blue flash. 
- ★ Log in to Times Table Rock Stars 5 days a week for a minimum of 10 mins.
- ★ Select one task from the coloured boxes to complete.
- ★ Practise spelling daily in preparation for a spelling test on Friday.

Optional

- ★ Select other activities to complete.
- ★ Take video or photos of your child completing the task- these can be uploaded to your child's dojo profile.
- ★ Use spelling words in made up sentences.
- ★ Practise writing numbers counting forwards and backwards to 100.

Some of the tasks will be practical tasks, to show your child has completed the task simply tick the box. Where the task asks for some recording your child can use their home learning book. We ask that your child fills up each page. Most tasks will not require a full page so multiple tasks could be completed on one page. A full page is more interesting to look at than one task per page.

Please Note

At Primrose Hill we understand life can be busy at times. Our weekly expectations have been set for the age of your child. Some of these activities can be completed at different times of the day and will not require your child to stop what they are doing to complete. For example the counting task could be completed on their walk to school.
