

COVID-19: GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS



Please **DO NOT** visit our school if;

- **You have recently developed a fever (a temperature above 38C)**
- **You have a new, continuous cough**
- **You have noticed a change to your sense of taste or smell**

As we continue to try to minimise the risk of COVID-19 infection across the Primrose Hill community, we ask for the support and understanding of our visitors.

Primrose Hill Primary School continues to take guidance from Public Health England, Salford Local Authority and the DfE in order to help us minimise the risk of COVID-19 transmission. **Taking this into account, we request all visitors to comply with the rules contained in this short policy.**

For the avoidance of potential embarrassment, we would like to advise you that Primrose Hill Primary school is currently operating a 'no handshake' policy. We are also unable to provide hot drinks at this time. We do apologise for not being able to provide you with our usual warm welcome, but we must take every precaution in order to look after the health and welfare of our pupils, staff and all of the other communities we are in contact with.

HOW YOU CAN HELP US:

- **Wash your hands frequently**, with soap and water. Please do this as soon as you enter our building. Please also use the hand sanitising gel around the school during your visit if you are unable to wash your hands as you move around our building.
- **Support the 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' campaign** by using tissues (or the crook of your elbow) whenever you need to cough or sneeze. Please place any used tissues in one of our lidded bins and wash your hands immediately.
- **Stay at least 2m apart from everyone in school.** Please do not stay in close proximity to anyone for any length of time and please do not share items with other people.
- Where possible, **keep the handling of items to a minimum.** Use your elbow to push buttons for doors. Do not hold the door open for others whilst they pass.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.**
- If you start to feel unwell during your visit, PLEASE GO HOME.
- Please follow the one way systems in operation. Please take note of the signs around school to ensure that you are not in an area where you should not be,
- ALWAYS wash your hands before leaving the building

It is important that all visitors respect and support all of the safety measures that we have put in place.
