How did we do?

- **65%** of the goals we set ourselves for 2022-23 were **FULLY ACHIEVED.**
- **31%** of targets were **PARTIALLY ACHIEVED.**
- **4%** of our aims were **NOT MET.**

Of our successes, we are particularly proud of our EYFS and KS2 results. Feedback from families about our school and its provision remains **STRONG**. Pupils say they feel **SAFE** here. We need to improve our KS1 results - particularly our combined scores.
