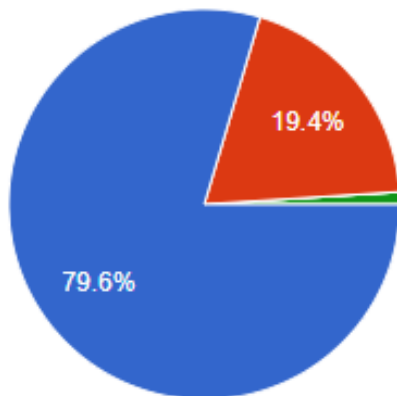


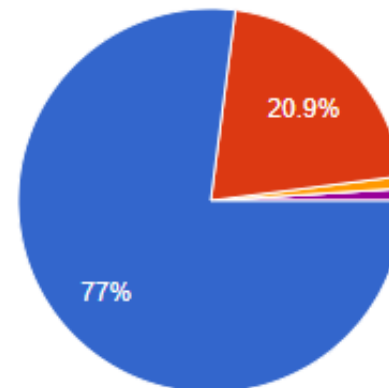
## My child is happy and likes coming to this school.

99% agree with this statement. 1% strongly disagreed.. No reason for this was given.



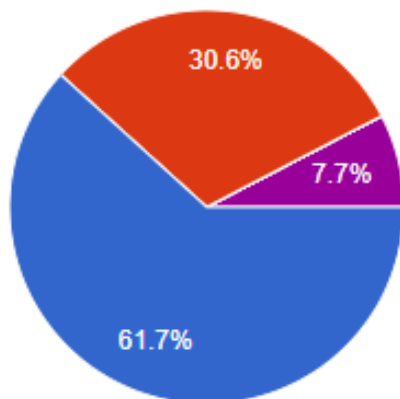
## My child tells me that they feel safe at this school.

## The red, yellow and green card system helps encourage children to be well behaved.

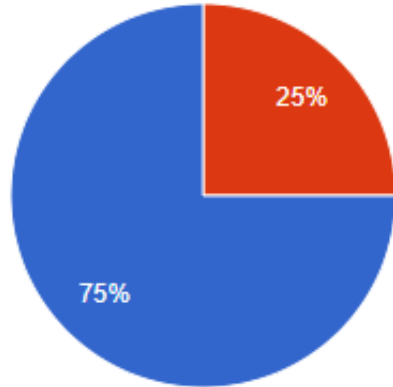
Just under 8% said that they did not know if our 'be good' policy encouraged children here to behave well. We need to ensure that all families understand and see the benefit of our approach.

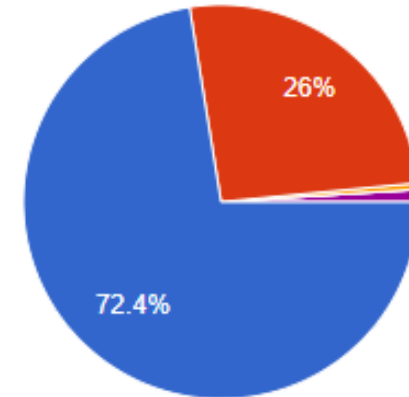
## School responds in a quick and effective manner when I need to speak to someone

We are very pleased that 100% of respondents agreed with this statement. School works hard to respond to all approaches and queries.



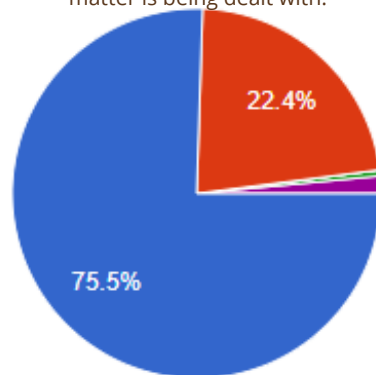
## The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

## The school has a clear message of saying no to bullies. I know I can go and report bullying behaviour to any adult in school.

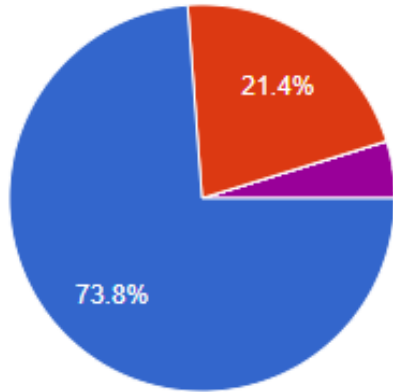
0.5% strongly disagreed with this statement. It is hoped that this family have approached school with their concerns and that this matter is being dealt with.

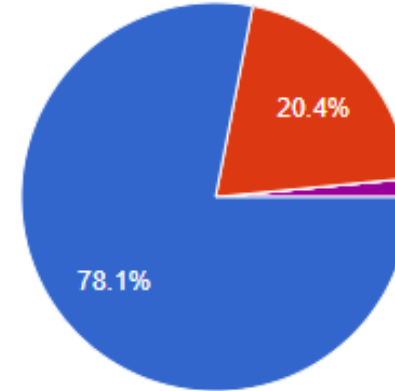
## My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed

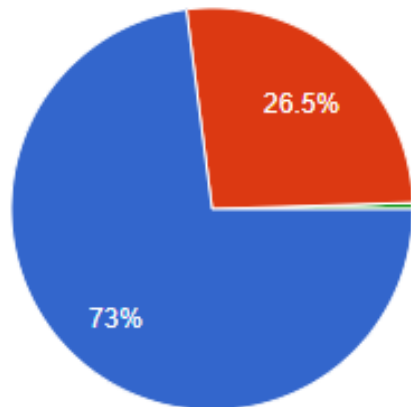
## The school wants the best for its pupils and has high expectations for my child

## My child is doing well at this school

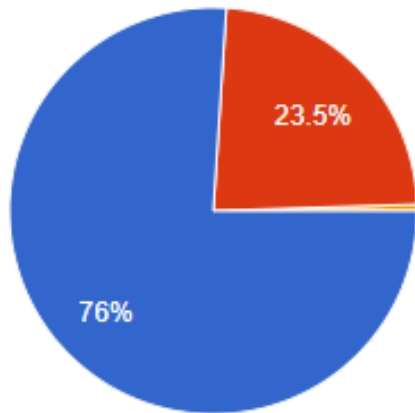
99.5% of families agreed with this view. One family did not. We are unsure as to why this is as no reason was left.

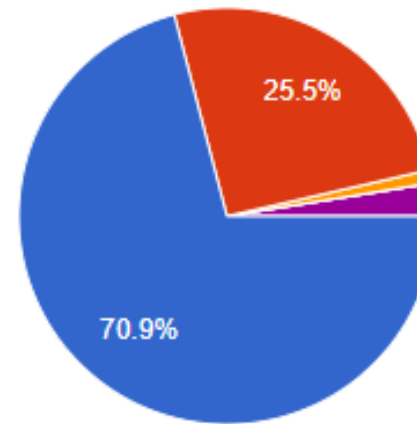
## The school lets me know how my child is doing in class

We achieve this through regular school reports, messages on Clasdojo, parent and carer evenings and family engagement sessions



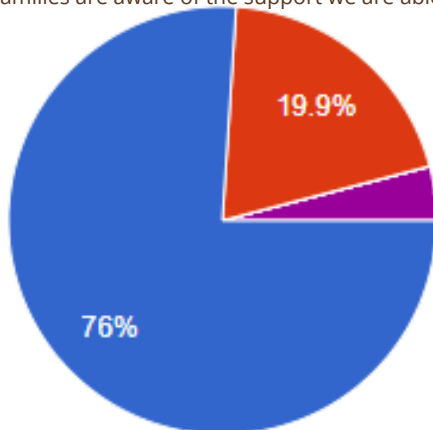
## The school supports children's wider personal development

We offer a wide range of free clubs, hold special events and mark special occasions here. Some families did however say that they would like to see even more clubs being offered.



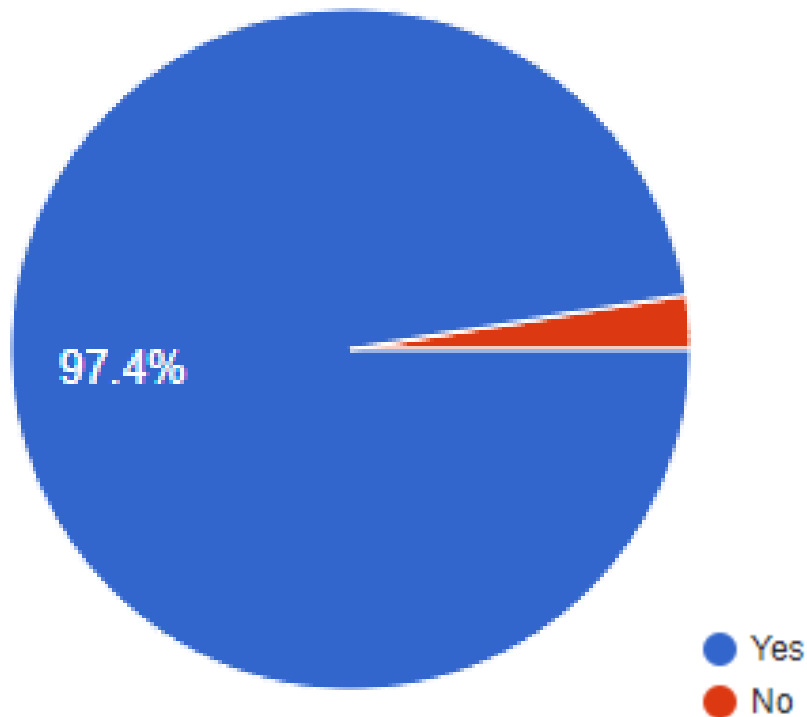
## The school is working hard to help with the cost of living crisis
