This is has remained almost the same as the previous year. The National was 60% in 2014. Salford was 56.8% and The Cluster was 54.4% in 2014.

The baseline for children entering Reception showed that when they started 0% were judged to be at expected development. The Primrose Hill baseline was that the children should be working within 30-50months in Communication, Language and Literacy, Physical and Personal, Social and Health. Considering that the children start at such a low baseline this shows good progress. This was a particularly poor cohort.

Y1 PHONICS TEST

79% of pupils attaining the expected level in the Year 1 phonics screening check:

Last year 53% of children attained the expected level. Nationally 74% of children achieved the expected level in 2015. This is a good improvement and above the National Average.
